The Federation of Artistic Roller Skating is the controlling body in the United Kingdom, for Figure, Free and Dance Skating on Rollers, including In-line skates

Academy Rules

- 1. That the Academy be called Sally's Academy of Roller Skating
- 2. That the object of the Academy be the promotion and cultivation of roller-skating.
- 3. That the Academy shall be affiliated to the Federation of Artistic Roller Skating, whose laws shall be preserved in every detail.
- 4. Membership shall be by application to the Academy Secretary for consideration.
- 5. That no member shall be allowed to compete in any club activities unless he/she has paid his/her Federation subscription.
- 6. That a member wishing to resign must do so in writing before the Annual General Meeting or he/she will be held liable for the ensuing year's subscription.
- 7. Any member acting in a manner derogatory to the Club shall have his/her conduct dealt with by the Committee, which shall afford the member the opportunity of being heard. The Committee shall have the power to expel the member by a majority of two-thirds of those present and voting. Any such members shall, however, have the right to appeal to a special General Meeting of the Club called for the purpose.
- 8. The Committee of the Academy shall consist of: Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary, Committee Members and Child Protection Officer (being fully paid-up Senior Members of the Club).
- 9. In the event of a Committee vacancy, the Committee shall have the power to fill that vacancy with a fully paid-up Senior Club Member. Such Members will have the same powers as though formally elected on at the AGM.
- 10. The Committee shall have the power to co-opt up to one third of their number. Such co-opted members may take full part in all discussions, but may not vote.
- 11. The Academy will uphold the FARS Child Protection policies as set down and as may be amended from time to time by FARS. A Form confirming the agreement to this statement to be sent to FARS for the records.
- 12. All members who have not attained the age of 18 must be registered as a child or young person and a **Parental Consent Form** held by the club.
- 13. All trainers/coaches/teachers or consultants (skating or sports active persons) employed either paid or unpaid must hold a FARS CPU approval coaches license. [Red license with photo].
- 14. Club Officials involved in the supervision of children and young people belonging to or associated with the Club must also be registered. [Green license with photo].
- 15. That discretionary power be given to the Academy Director to deal with any matter not provided for in these rules.
- 16. That an Annual General Meeting must be held each year, at which all Academy Officials must attend.
- 17. Any skater wishing to skate for another club or academy shall seek prior permission from the Academy Director (which shall not unreasonably be with held)
- 18. Any skater given permission to skate for another club or academy whilst being a member of Sally's Academy of Roller Skating shall adopt both club names on any competition entries.
- 19. No competitive restrictions shall be imposed on any member who wishes to leave the Club.
- 20. During skating activities for the Academy for safety reasons any skater must remove their skates before leaving the skating rink / immediate skating location.
- 21. That none of the foregoing Rules be altered except at the Annual General Meeting or at a Special General Meeting convened for that purpose, of which seven clear days notice must be given.
